Citizens, Member of NGOs, Students and Teachers from Solapur and Shivaji University affiliated colleges were present. The training programme had four technical sessions with themes varying from introduction to Human Rights, Human Rights Institutions in India, Rights</p>

of Women and Children and Rights of other vulnerable groups respectively. The Sessions were aimed at developing an understanding of human rights and its application in the field by participant with the help of experts from the field of Human Rights.

Inauguration Function:-

The Inauguration of the programme was done by **Shri Prabhakar Deshmukh (Former Divisional Secretary, Kokan Division)**. In his speech he explained the importance of the Global Human Rights Declaration of 1948 and also explained the importance of Human Rights in the overall development of human beings. The Function was presided over by **Hon'ble Shri. Baburaoji Gaikwad**. In his presidential address he opined that one should be aware of one's own rights, and told the importance of educational rights in life. I/C Principal **Dr. Arjun Masal** made an introductory speech. In his speech, he spoke about the training programme and how it focuses on sensitizing students and faculty members on human rights issues.

Prof. Mane J. V. (Dept. of Political Science) the convener of the programme made an introduction of the Chief Guest and gave a brief about the sessions to be carried out during the training programme and a brief introduction about the resource persons. The inaugural ceremony ended with the vote of thanks delivered by Prof. Tamboli J.M. (Dept. of Political Science). The programme was anchored by prof. Santosh Kamble .

One Day Basic Training Programme on Human Rights held in four session.

First Session:- Introduction to Human Rights

The Resource person of the first session was **Dr. Sushil Shinde** (HOD. Political Science Dept, Art and Commerce College, Madha and Senate Member, Solapur University Solapur). He explained the concept of Human Rights and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Then the speaker spoke about the fundamental rights and the directive principles of state policy stated in the Indian constitution and how these have been

borrowed from the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. First session was presided by institution **Chairman Hon'ble Baburaoji Gaikwad** and **Prof. Dr. T. R. Mane** made an introductory speech.

He has given information about Child and Women's Rights.The session was very informative and enriching. 





693 attendees were present through the YouTube channel.

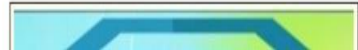
